



Christian Prisoner Fellowship License Procedures and Guidelines

To obtain a Christian Prisoner Fellowship (CPF) Volunteer Chaplain license:

1. One must be affiliated with the United Pentecostal Church International in some way. Attend a UPCI church with a licensed UPCI pastor that would recommend and sign the application or if not attending a UPCI church, have knowledge of a UPCI pastor that would recommend and sign the application.
2. Purchase a C.P.F. Study guide/Workbook, which includes the application to become a C.P.F. Volunteer Chaplain. ***NOTE*** Each person getting certified will need to purchase a study guide/workbook. These materials are copyrighted and cannot be photocopied.
3. After purchasing the workbook, you must: read through the study guide, fill out the application, answer the questions on the final exam, and type out the answers to the essay questions.
4. Return the application, test, essay questions, a 2x2 inch picture, and the licensing fee to Home Missions Division • 8855 Dunn Rd • Hazelwood, MO 63042. For a one-year license, please remit \$35 with this application. You may purchase a two-year license for \$59. This non-refundable fee for your License Fee needs to be made payable to Home Missions Division
5. The above study guide is \$10 (plus \$5.00 for shipping and handling) and can be purchased through our inventory/shipping company called CNI at toll-free 866-819-7667. For mail in orders, the address can be obtained by calling the above toll-free number.
